### DESCRIPTION AND USES

Zinsser<sup>®</sup> Wood Bleach is designed to brighten all wood surfaces including trim, paneling, floors and furniture. It bleaches new or stripped wood to a lighter, more uniform color.

### PRODUCT APPLICATION

#### **IMPORTANT**

This product is for indoor use only. Test on inconspicuous area before applying to ensure favorable results. Use eye protection and rubber gloves during use. Avoid breathing vapors. Ensure fresh air entry during application and drying.

#### **SURFACE PREPARATION**

ALL SURFACES: Remove all dirt, grease, oil, salt and chemical contaminants by washing the surface with Krud Kutter<sup>®</sup> Original Cleaner Degreaser, commercial detergent or other suitable cleaner. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water and allow to fully dry. All surfaces must be dry at time of application. Remove loosely adhered previous coatings by scraping and sanding. Remove all sanding dust and dirt with a vacuum and grease or glue with a clean rag dampened with mineral spirits.

WARNING! If you scrape, sand or remove old paint, you may release lead dust. LEAD IS TOXIC. EXPOSURE TO LEAD DUST CAN CAUSE SERIOUS ILLNESS SUCH AS BRAIN DAMAGE, ESPECIALLY IN CHILDREN. ## PRODUCT APPLICATION (cont.)

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Spread a solvent resistant drop cloth around the work area in case of drips or spills. Protect eyes and skin. Wear safety goggles and chemical resistant gloves. Amount of bleaching will vary with the type of wood and length of treatment time.

Use separate plastic or glass container for each solution. Do Not mix B with A solution or with any other product.

Apply Solution A with a new sponge, completely saturating the area to be bleached. Let stand 5 minutes for soft woods and 10 minutes for hard woods. While surface is still wet, use another sponge to apply Solution B over Solution A. Let stand overnight to dry.

Sand lightly to remove residue and lighten wood. If a lighter shade is desired, repeat the process.

Once desired look is achieved, the surface should be neutralized with vinegar diluted with 2 parts water.

**CAUTION!** Avoid contact with eyes and skin. If eye contact occurs, flush with water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, seek medical attention. Avoid contact with the skin. Wash exposed areas with soap and water. Do not take internally. **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.**
